

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PLEASANT VALLEY NO. 288

BYLAW NO. 02-2026

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A WEIGHT RESTRICTION IN THE ORGANIZED HAMLET OF FISKE

The council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PART 1 – PURPOSE AND DEFINITIONS

Purpose

1. The purposes of this bylaw is to establish a vehicle weight management system to regulate the weight of vehicles, or vehicles with their loads, using particular municipal roadways in the Organized Hamlet of Fiske.

Definitions

2. (1) The words used in this bylaw shall have the meanings ascribed to them in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*.

(2) In this bylaw:
 - (a) “Administrator” means the administrator of the municipality;
 - (b) “Council” shall mean the Council of the municipality;
 - (c) “Minister” means the member of the Executive Council to whom for the time being the administration of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, is assigned;
 - (d) “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288;
 - (e) “Order” means an order issued by the road committee; and
 - (f) “Committee” means a road management committee established in accordance with section 81 of *The Municipalities Act* for the purpose of issuing orders.

PART 2 – VEHICLE WEIGHTS

Weight Limits on Certain Roads

3. No person shall, without a permit issued pursuant to section 36 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, operate or move or cause to be operated or moved on or over a street in the Hamlet of Fiske a vehicle, the gross vehicle weight of which exceeds 5 Tons (4,536 kilograms) on the portion of “Millar Street” located south from 2nd Avenue to 1st Avenue North in the Organized Hamlet of Fiske and as shown on the map attached as Appendix “A”

Signs

4. Signs indicating the maximum weight allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the restricted weight zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the restricted weight zone area.

Exemptions

5. The restrictions set out in Sections 3 of this bylaw shall not apply to those vehicles described in Section 3 of *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*.

Permits

6. (1) Notwithstanding Sections 3 and 4 of this bylaw, the Administrator may, if satisfied that the vehicle or combination of vehicles can be operated or moved upon the Hamlet Street without damage to the roadway or other property, issue a permit to the registered owner of the vehicle or combination of vehicles to exceed the maximum gross vehicle weights fixed by this bylaw.

(2) The Administrator shall, in the permit, designate the municipal roadways that may be used and the vehicle shall then be operated on only such municipal roadways as are designated.

PART 3 ENFORCEMENT

Penalty

7. Any person guilty of an infraction to any of the provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties described in Schedule A of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* for the Province of Saskatchewan. Contravening a minister’s order (road ban) or weight and dimension regulations by exceeding permit weight or other conditions.
- Schedule A, Category D: Fines to a maximum of \$1,000, or \$2,000 if a corporation.
