

R.M. OF PLEASANT VALLEY NO. 288

BYLAW NO. 1-2012

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "municipal road" means a public highway or municipality owned roadway that is under the direction, management and control of the municipality;
 - b) "public highway" means a road allowance or a road, street or lane vested in or owned by the province including anything erected on or in connection with the public highway;
 - c) "provincial highway" means a public highway or a proposed public highway under the direction, management and control of the Department of Highways and Transportation: and
 - d) "roadway" means that part of a public highway designed or intended for use by vehicles but does not include a trail designated under *The Snowmobile Act* or path for which a permit is required;

2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 60 kilometers per hour on the municipal roads described as follows:
 - That portion of the "Bickleigh Grid" located from Highway #7 south then West of Sections 13,12,1-29-18-W3, West of Sections 36,25,24,13-28-18-W3, North of the South Half of Section 13-28-18-W3, West of Sections 18,7,6-28-18-W3 to the South Boundary of the R.M. of Pleasant Valley No. 288.
 - That portion of the "D'Arcy Grid" located from Highway #7 south then West of Section 7 & 6-29-18-W3, West of Sections 31,30,19,18,7,6-28-18-W3, then South of Section 6-28-18-W3 then one mile East to then South to the R.M. of Snipe Lake No. 259 boundary.


3. Signs indicating the maximum speed 60 kilometers per hour shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.

4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an Offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.

5. This bylaw comes into effect upon approval of The Highway Traffic Board.


