A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PLEASANT VALLEY NO. 288

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

This bylaw shall be known as the "Recovery of Protective Services Costs Bylaw

1. In this bylaw:

a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;

b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and

- c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with:
 - Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
 - The rates contained within Schedule A may be revised from time to time, and updated as revised.
- 3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
