

BYLAW NO. P5, 1978

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS IN
THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PLEASANT VALLEY No. 288

The council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:-

1. In this bylaw:

"road" means any road allowance within the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288 other than:

- (i) a private road;
- (ii) a provincial highway;
- (iii) a road or highway within the following hamlets, namely:

Anglia
Fiske
McGee
Ridpath

- 2. No building shall be situated a distance of less than 150 feet from the centre line of any road.
- 3. No building shall be situated a distance of less than 300 feet from an intersection of roads.
- 4. This bylaw shall not apply with respect to buildings situated prior to the passing of the bylaw.
- 5. Every person who causes a building to be situated in contravention of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Pleasant Valley No. 288.
- 6. Bylaw number T6, 1977, passed April 12, 1977 is hereby repealed.
