What is **Single Stream** recycling?

Single Stream Recycling is as easy as it gets. It allows all recyclables to be placed in one bin without sorting or separating. After your recyclables are collected, they are brought back to our state-of-the-art Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) where they are processed to recover as much as possible.

Benefits of Single Stream Recycling

- Most user-friendly for participants – no sorting required!
- More recyclables are diverted away from the landfill with single stream versus two or three stream programs due to increased user participation.

<p>Paper Newspapers, flyers, mail, magazines, paper</p> <p>All cardboard boxes and cartons (pizza, cereal, tissue, laundry) <i>No food residue in boxes previously containing food</i></p> <p>Cardboard egg cartons and paper tubes</p>													

*Please rinse/clean containers before putting them into recycling carts.

Note: Shredded Paper: place in a clean, full-size (77-litre) plastic bag (only exception to no plastic bag rule)
