

BYLAW NO. 2-99


A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES


Whereas the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires; therefore,

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Marriott No. 317 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned or operated landfill located within the boundaries of the Municipality.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person who contravenes the provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to (the penalty provided for by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality or other specified penalty).


